The Milford Chamber of Commerce Trust will award the attached scholarships in 2011. Only one application needs to be completed for the all scholarships that are listed.

Please carefully read the requirements for each application. While the **requirements for information on each are similar, there are differences.** You will see differences in the amount of the award, qualifications for application, the type of program for which the scholarship may be used, and residency requirements. Some scholarships are need based and others are academically based.

Some scholarships are for all fields of study, some specifically for business, medical related fields, science, engineering, and culinary. The Humanitarian Scholarship as well as the two Golden Hands Scholarships is geared especially for a student who uses their hands. Read the requirements of each scholarship carefully before applying.

The criteria for many of the awards and scholarships are to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the committee **financial need, academic standing, character, civic endeavor and community spirit. The academic based scholarships are awarded wholly on academic achievement, and do not require financial reporting.**

All scholarship winners will be required to attend the award luncheon at noon on May 20th at Aldario's Restaurant and write a thank you note to the sponsor of the application as a requirement to receive their award. You must be present at the Scholarship Luncheon to collect your scholarship award, or it will be forfeited.

Applications are now being accepted and must be to your guidance office no later than April 1st. The Guidance Office must have the applications to the Milford Chamber of Commerce, 5 North Broad Street, Milford, CT 06460 no later than April 8, 2011.

All applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee which is composed of member representatives of the Milford Chamber of Commerce. All applications become the property of the Milford Chamber of Commerce. They will be kept confidential, and will be destroyed after the final selections are made.

14. **The Marcel Bich Memorial Scholarship - \$1,000**

- In memory of Marcel Bich, the founder of the BIC Corporation.
- Will be awarded to an employee or a child of an employee of a member of the Milford Chamber of Commerce.
- The chamber member company must be a member in "good standing" at the time of the application and award.
- Will be awarded to a graduating high school student beginning his or her first year of study at a college or university majoring in the area of science, technology, engineering or bio-science or vocational, trade or business school.
